  - most important to customers
- Overall aim for more unified understanding/ definition of sustainable food





## What have we been up to?

#### 3. New regional procurement working group

- Out of scope for this project timeline?
- DPUK and Dixon Foundation fund
  - facilitated meetings with anchor institution catering and procurement leads
  - 20+ people attended first meeting
  - Notable interest in DPS and support for a NESFA application to Dixon for funding
  - NESFA applied and were successful with stage 1 funding. This will add notable resource to this aspect of the project.
