- As of 6th April, applications no longer need a health professional's signature
 - Earlier applications held until the 6th for processing
 - New regulations passed in prep for digital rollout

- Digitisation = online application form + smartcard

 - Aim to roll out in 2020 (??), including new branding

- Emphasis on relationship between schools and catering partners
- Clarification received re: schools getting full UIFSM and FSM Grants
- Voucher system £15 per week lobbying for extension of redemption to Aldi, Lidl, Coop, independents, local food distributors

- Easter holidays now included for vouchers & schools can apply for grants if financial losses for other costs.
- Eligibility re UIFSM & No Recourse to Public Funds
