Create a long-term Food Strategy and Action Plan for the region. Improve physical and mental health through access to good food.

Strengthen the food sector, bringing food providers and local suppliers together, identifying gaps and creating solutions. Promote sustainable food and campaign to improve our food system to provide better outcomes to residents.



WHAT DO THE ARUN & CHICHESTER FOOD PARTNERSHIP DO?

CURRENT WORK AREAS:

- Community mapping to help identify and promote existing services.
- Consulting with the community to identify what is wanted and needed.
- Working with District & County Councils to try and get food issues on the agenda.
- Working with projects to increase their support offer through signposting info & access to in-person advice.
- Supporting the development of new community food projects.
- Project to review and promote the Healthy Start scheme to increase access to nutritious food for families on low incomes
- Creating local community networks and learning events.
- Working with Sustainable Food Places on nationally coordinated campaigns
- Next steps creation of long-term strategy based on consultation and events feedback
